History	In December 1976, the State Government announced the provision of funds for Neighbourhood Centres. In early 1977 the Wollongong City Council received a grant of \$18, 000 from the state government to help fund neighbourhood centres in the Illawarra. In April 1977 The Wollongong Neighbourhood Development Committee was established by the City Council. It's main objective being to plan, co-ordinate and develop neighbourhood centres and activities throughout the Illawarra. In August 1977 a Neighbourhood Development Co-ordinator was appointed. She resigned in March 1979. Subsequently both the position and the committee was abolished.
