**History** Peter Ebenezer Wedd was in his fifties when he joined the engineers of the Australian Army after his son was reported missing in France in 1916. Prior to the war he had been a member of the state executive of the Australian Labour party in Western Australia.

**Record Summary** Photocopy of a letter from P.E. Wedd to his wife in Perth, Australia. The letter reflects the high morale of Allied troops at the end of the war and the inveighs against conscientious objectors and the war atrocities of the German soldiers.
