A *Articles/Books/Reports*

B *Cases*

C *Legislation*

D *Treaties*

E *Other*

The references in your bibliography should be divided into these sections

The following are NOT included:

- Full stops
- Pinpointers
- Place of publication
- Date of retrieval for internet materials
