

Where will I find anti-discrimination legislation?

Answer:

There are a number of resources to use for identifying and accessing the full text of legislation. We recommend you try **Lawlex** and **CCH Online** first.

[Lawlex](#)

Lawlex provides access to the full text of legislation for all Australian jurisdictions. It refers you to the most authoritative database for each jurisdiction.

- At Keywords type in name of act
- Select appropriate jurisdiction

CCH Online provides electronic access to subject specific services, or e-looseleaf services, published by CCH.
