- Highlight **CaseBase Cases**
- Click **Search**
- Click on the name of the case
- Click **Cases referring to this case**
- e.g. Applied, Followed or overruled

[Legal Online: FirstPoint](#)

Combines the Australian Case Citator with the Australian Digest to provide citator information and case summaries. **Some fulltext** (those reports published by Legal Online and to which we subscribe to in print e.g.. *Commonwealth Law Reports*). Updated daily.

- At **Legal Online** under **Search** type case name
- Highlight **FirstPoint**
- Type in the *case name* in the Case Title field e.g. *Commonwealth v Yarmirr*
- Click **Search**
- Click on the Case Title e.g. *Commonwealth v Yarmirr*
- Click **Cases Citing** for a list of cases citing this case and how the courts have considered it e.g. Applied, Followed or overruled
- If the full text is unavailable **decode** the abbreviations using the resources listed in Question 5.
- Then do a **Title** search and/or **Journal Title** search on the Library [Catalogue](#) look up the title of the law report series for the **fulltext** of the case
