Lawlex Full text

A very good source of up-to-date **full text** legislation for most jurisdictions. Lawlex will direct you to the most authoritative legislation database for the relevant jurisdiction. For example, when searching for NSW legislation you will be directed to the Parliamentary Counsel's Office or Comlaw for Cth legislation. The Lawlex Premium Research function in Lawlex also provides easy access to:

- Second Reading Speeches
- Explanatory Memoranda
- Pending Legislation.

TIP:

- Sign in - "Click here" to continue as the University of Wollongong Research User
- Use the keyword search to locate the appropriate act
- Click on the title of the appropriate act

Austlii Full text

This is a publicly accessible site produced by the Australasian Legal Information Institute (a joint facility of UTS and UNSW.)

TIP:

- At **Austlii** click **Advanced Search**
- Use the **Find** drop down menu to select the appropriate search method
e.g. **this legislation name**
- Limit your search to **All Legislation Databases**.
- Click on the title of the appropriate act

E-looseleaf services and loose-leafservices are a very good source for identifying relevant legislation and for obtaining the **full text** of that legislation. Use the following databases to identify relevant e-looseleaf services.

- [Legal Online Full text](#)

Use the search facilities within the database or look for relevant libraries within each of these databases. For example, if looking for legislation on sexual harassment in CCH Online:

- Click Aust & NZ Equal Opportunity Law Library
- Click State equal Opportunity Legislation
- Click NSW Anti-Discrimination Act 1977

Some loose-leaf services are only available in hard copy. E.g. *Australian health and medical law reporter*. Use the Library Catalogue and do a keyword or subject search to identify and locate such items within the Library.
