Lawlex has a lot of useful Bills information. The **Bills Tracking** option contains:

- Full text of the bill (via external providers e.g. Comlaw and NSW Legislation – PCO NSW)
- Bill's progress from 1st reading to assent includes stages and dates of all 3 readings
- Assent date
- Whether the Bill was amended or failed

TIPS:

- At **Lawlex** homepage sign in – “**Click here** to continue as the University of Wollongong Research User”
- Click **Search legislation**
- Select relevant jurisdiction and year
- Click on title of Bill to get the Core Document Page
- Click on the title of the Bill again to get the full text of the Bill

Situated on the Australia Parliament web site, this gives access to the full text of Bills by title, portfolio and private member . Also access from here Second Reading Speeches & Explanatory Memoranda. Also contains a **Bills Digest** produced by the Parliamentary Library, which gives a summary of the purpose of the Bill and a brief history of its passage through Parliament. See also **Daily Bills Lists** of both the House and the Senate.
