Try a keywords search on the [UOW Library Catalogue](#) using terms such as **maritime and law** ; **sea and law**; **admiralty and law** ; **territor* and water***, **ocean and law**, **fisher* and marine**

Try these relevant subject headings e.g.

- **maritime law**
- **law of the sea**
- **territorial waters**
- **fisheries australia**

Broader subject headings such as **International Law** and **Marine Resources** may also be useful.
