

Q1: Where will I find a clear outline of the principles of OH&S law?

Answer:

1a. Books on occupational health & safety will include relevant cases, statutes and principles. Try a keyword search on the [UOW Library Catalogue](#) using the phrase **occupational health and safety**. Also try adding the word **law** on a new line.

Follow the relevant subject headings **within records**. Some examples include:
